

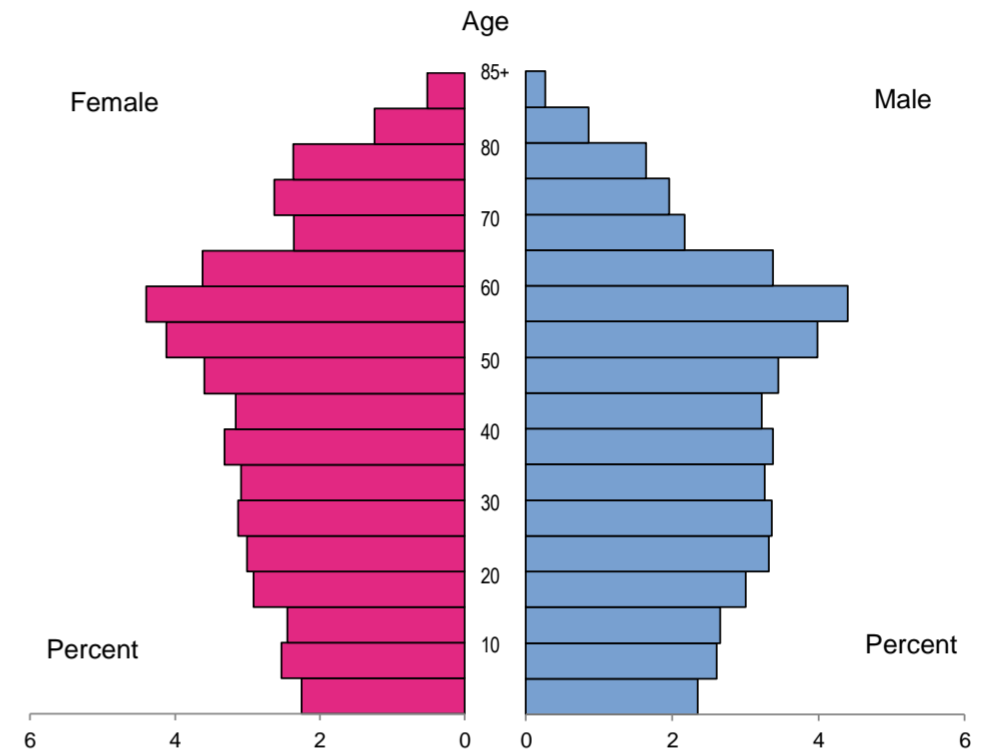

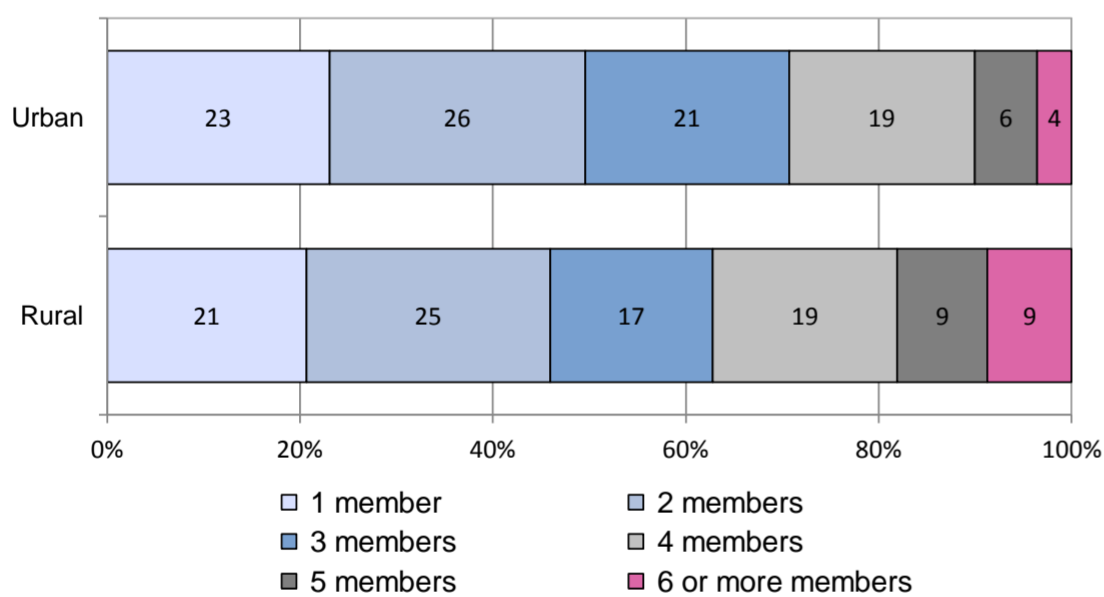

Population by sex and age, 2011 (%)



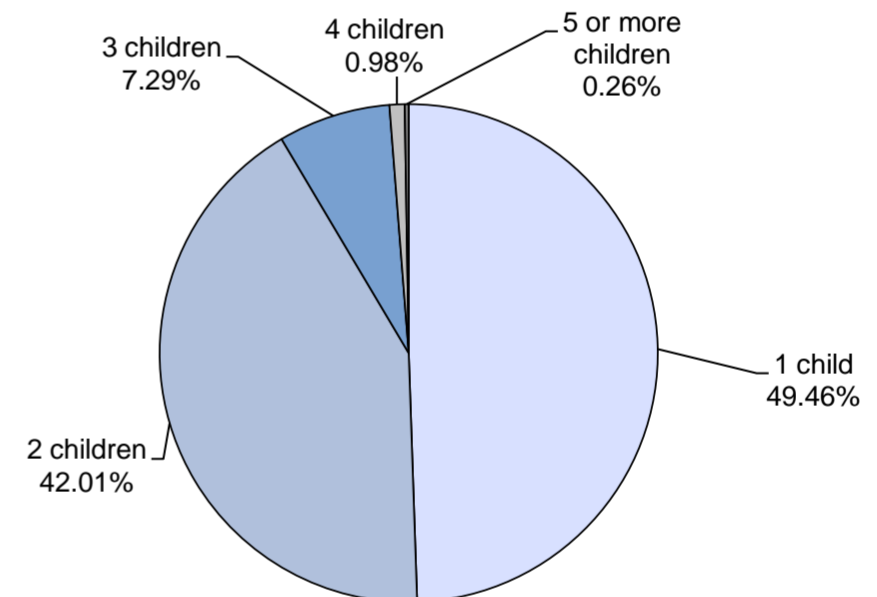

Families with children, by number of children, 2011. (%)



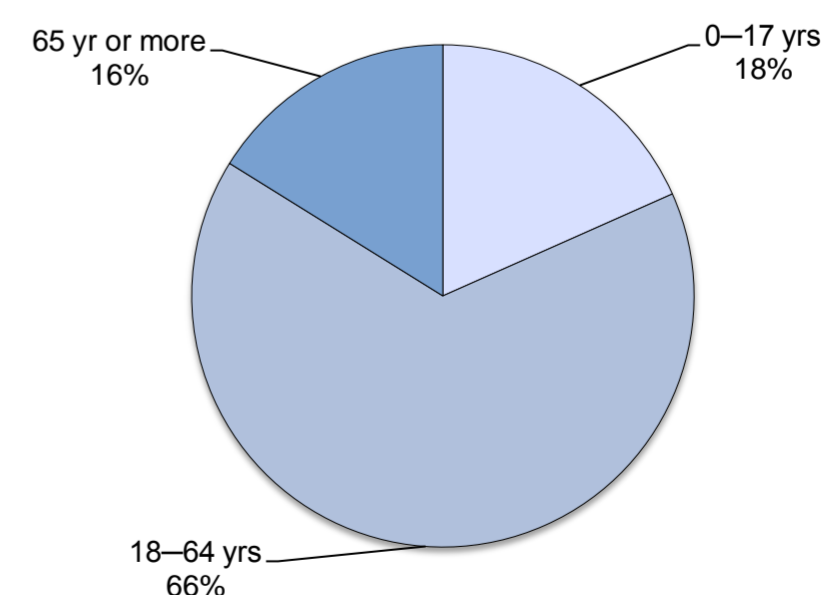

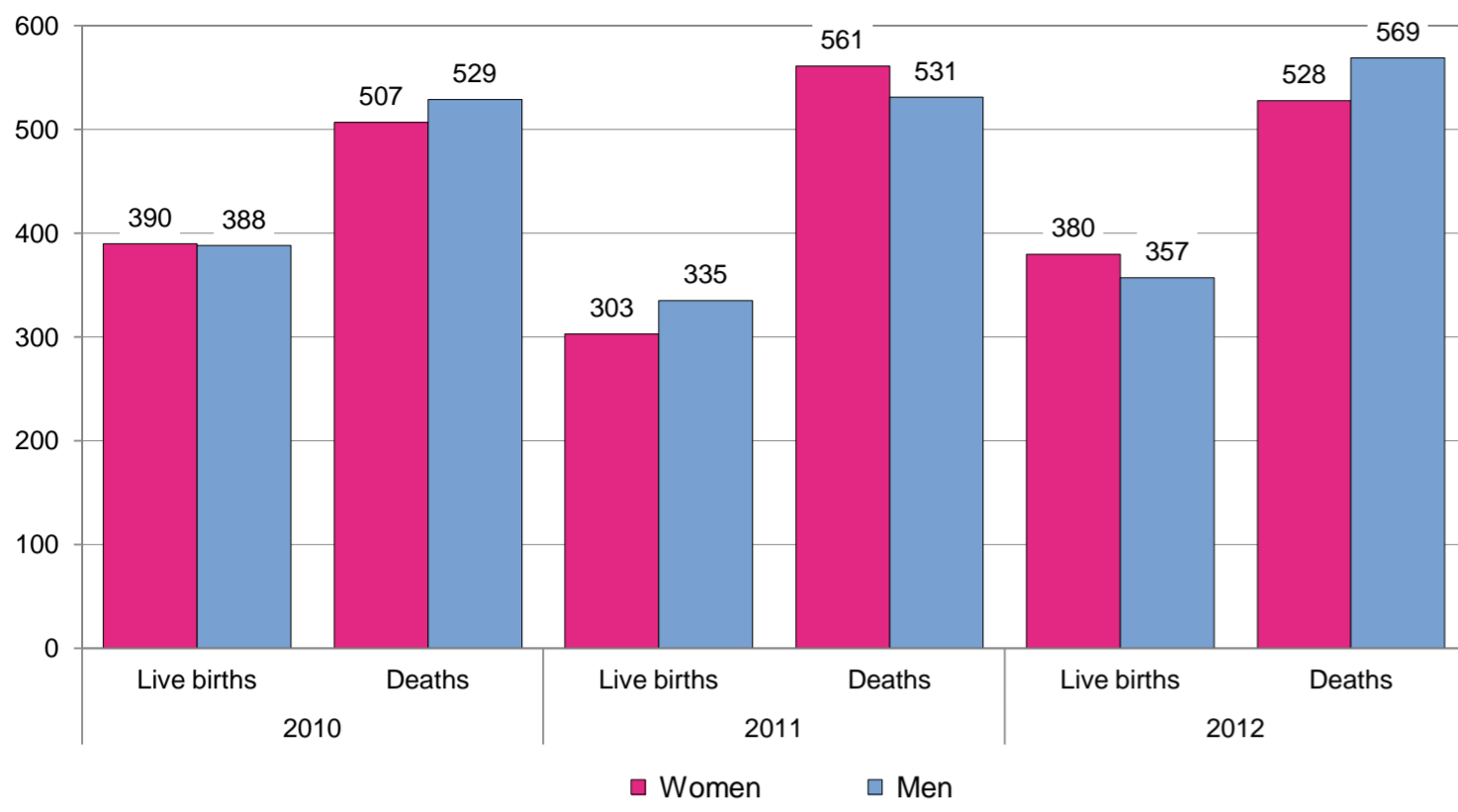

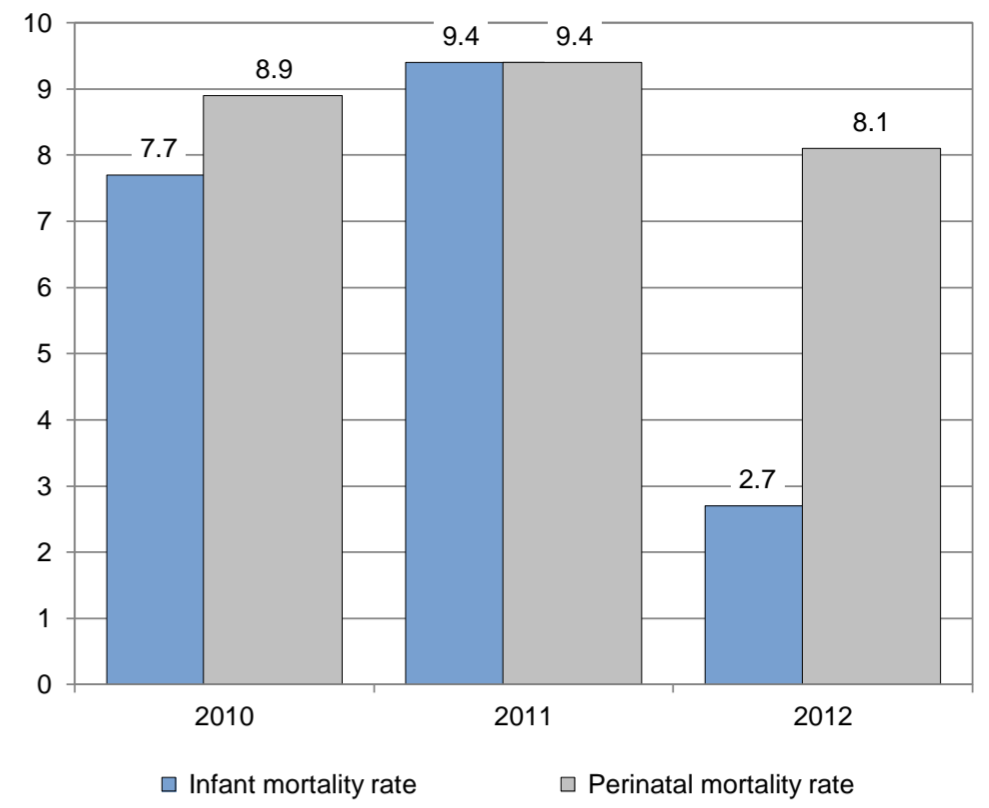
Number of live births and deaths, by sex, 2010–2012

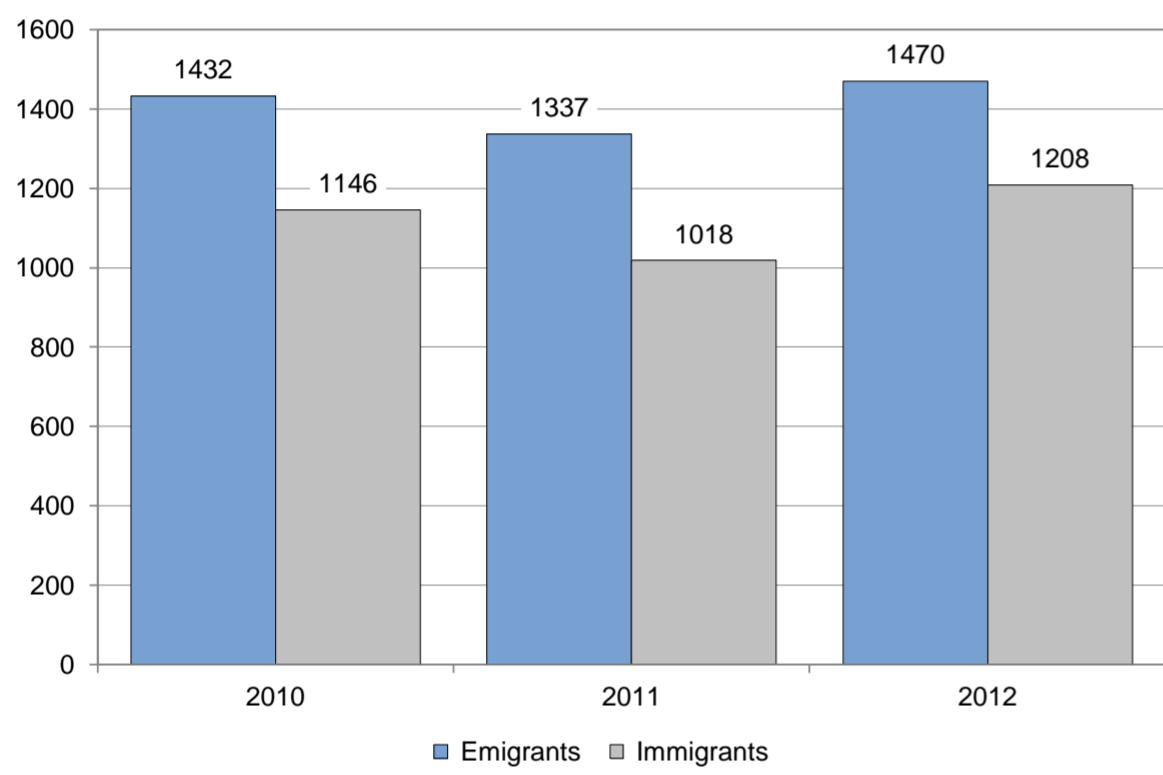
Death rates, 2010–2012

children under 1 yr (infants) and under 7 days



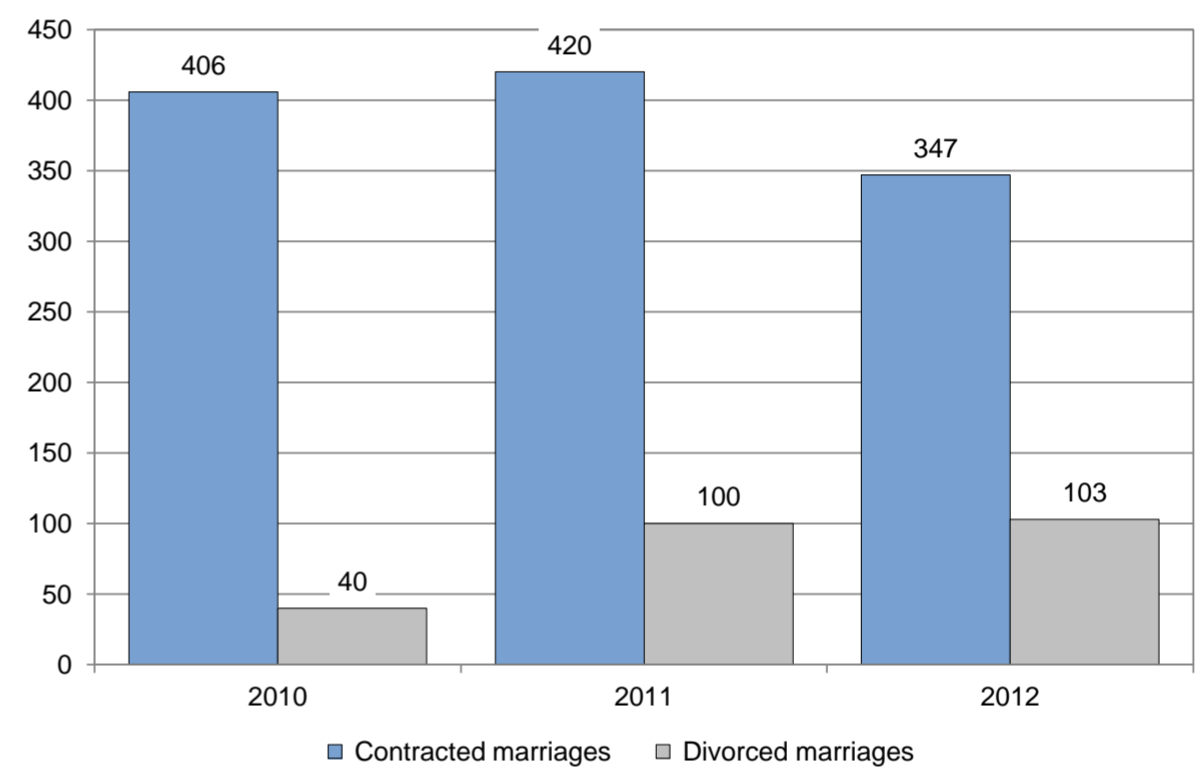

Number of contracted and divorced marriages, 2010–2012

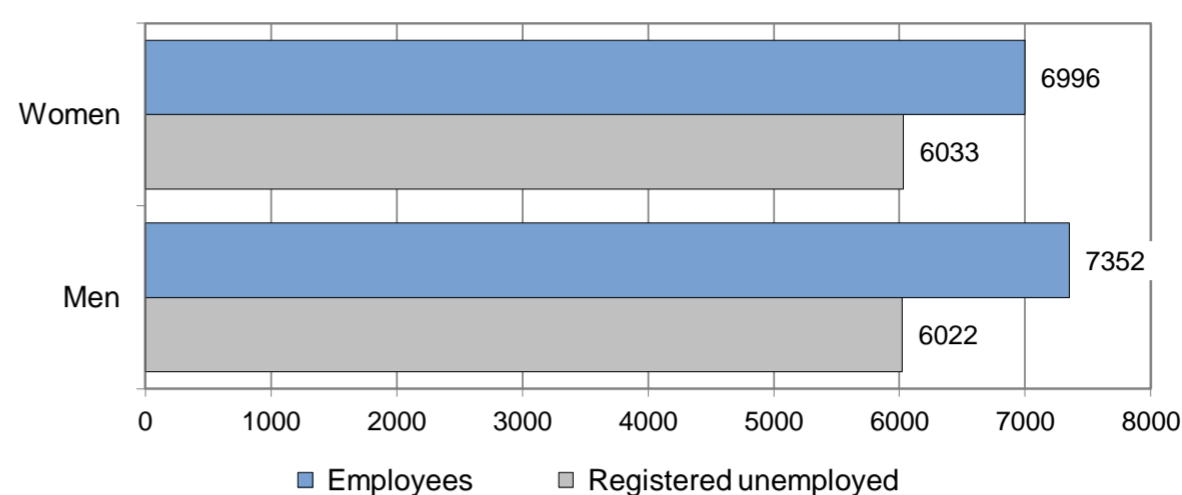

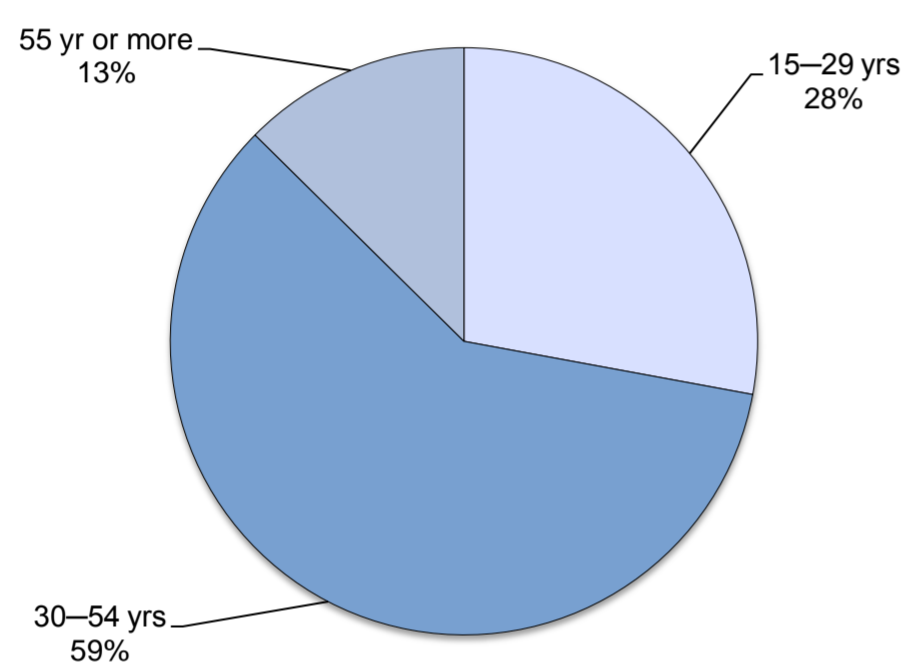

Number of employees and registered unemployed, by sex, 2013



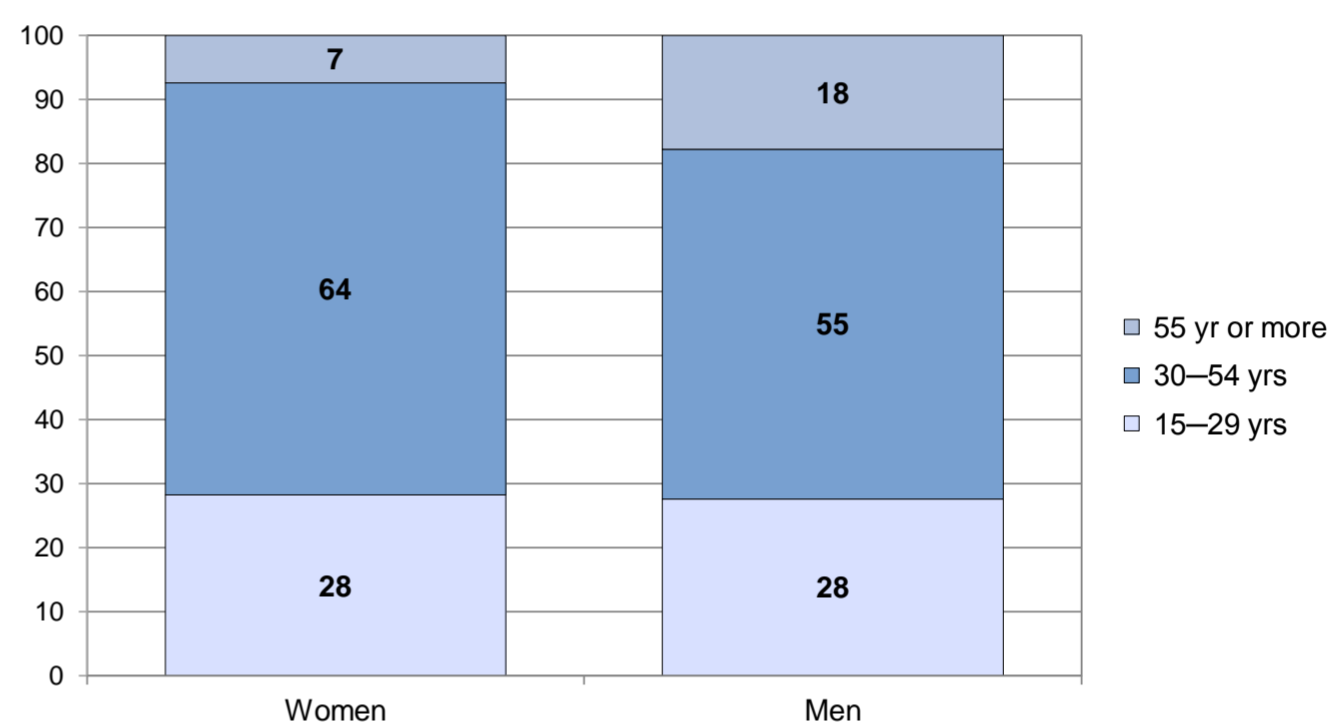

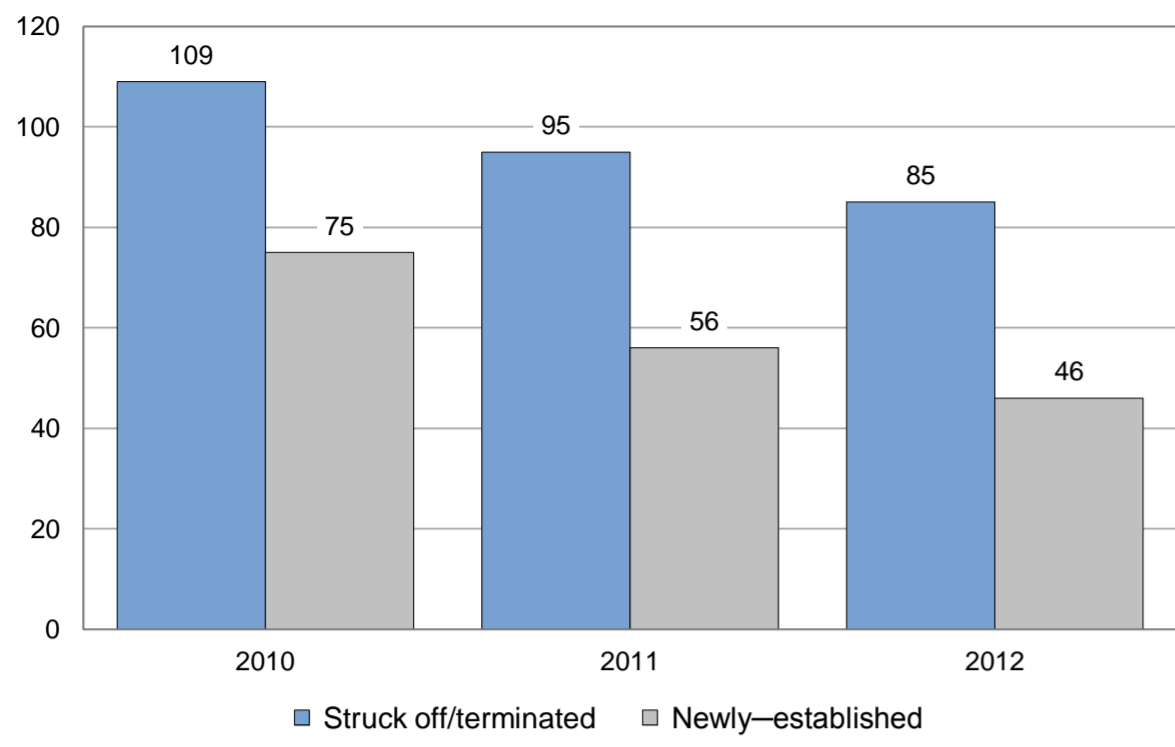

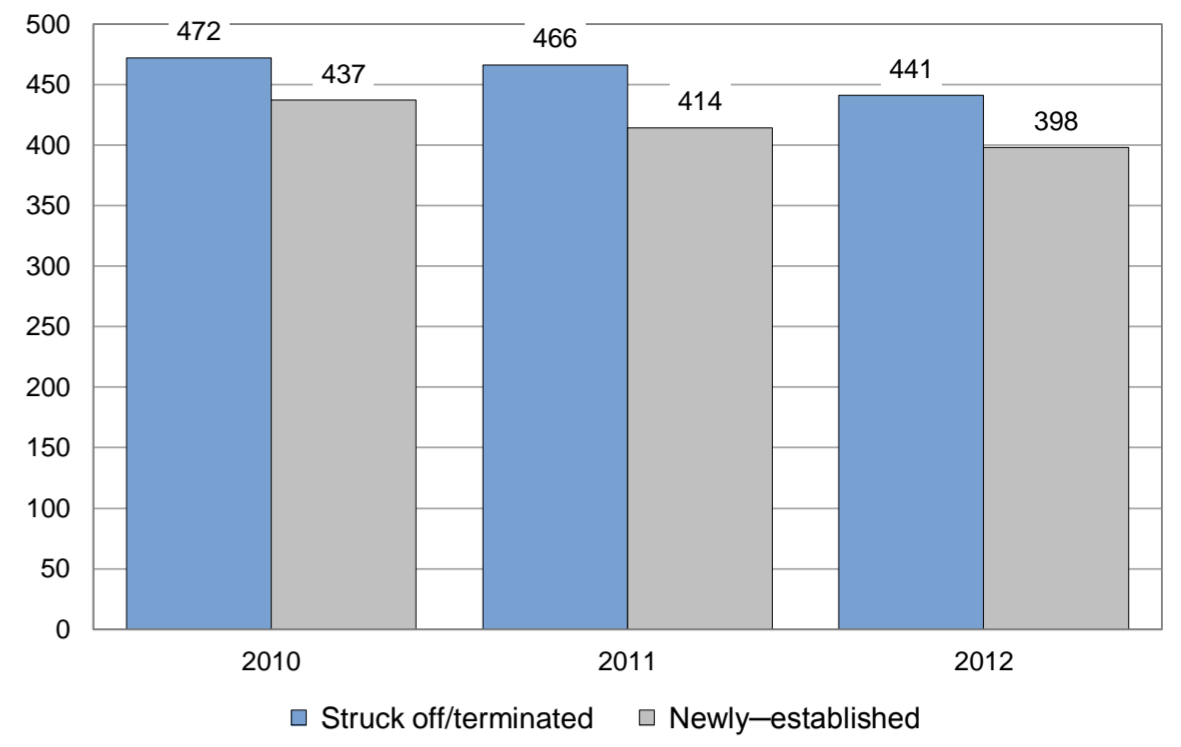

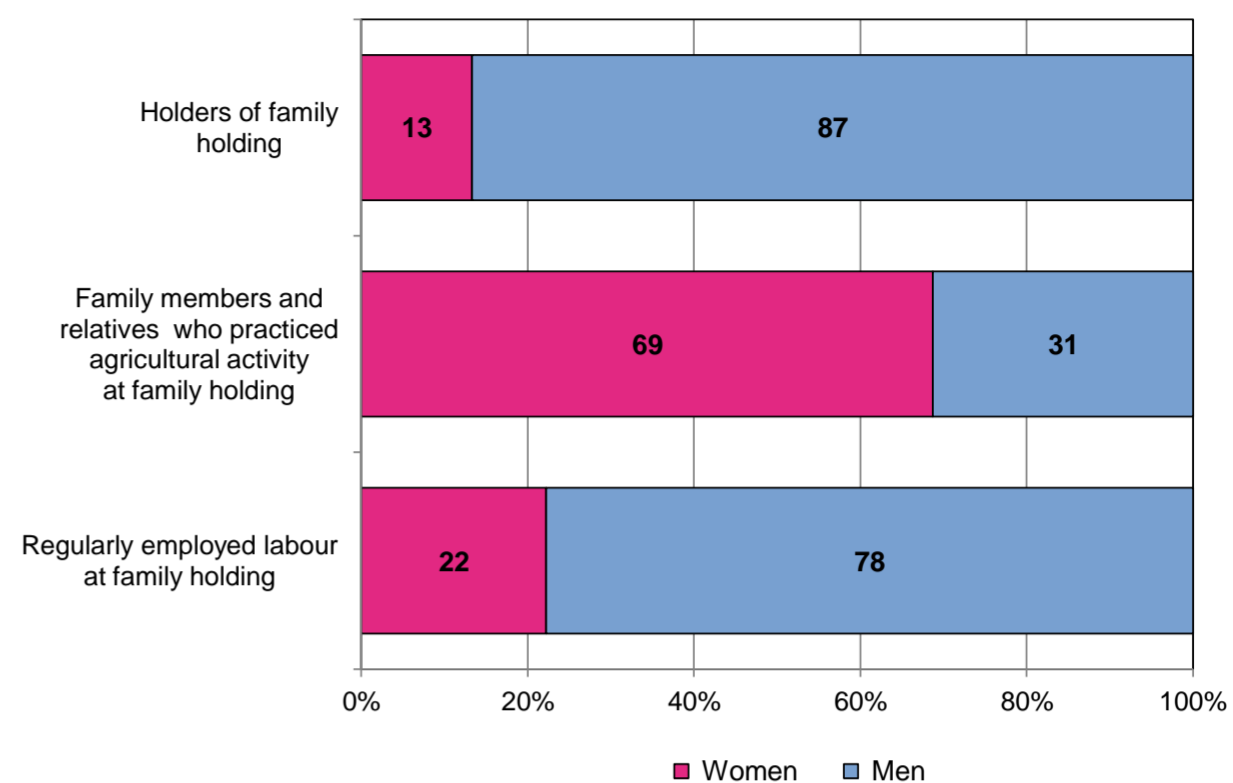

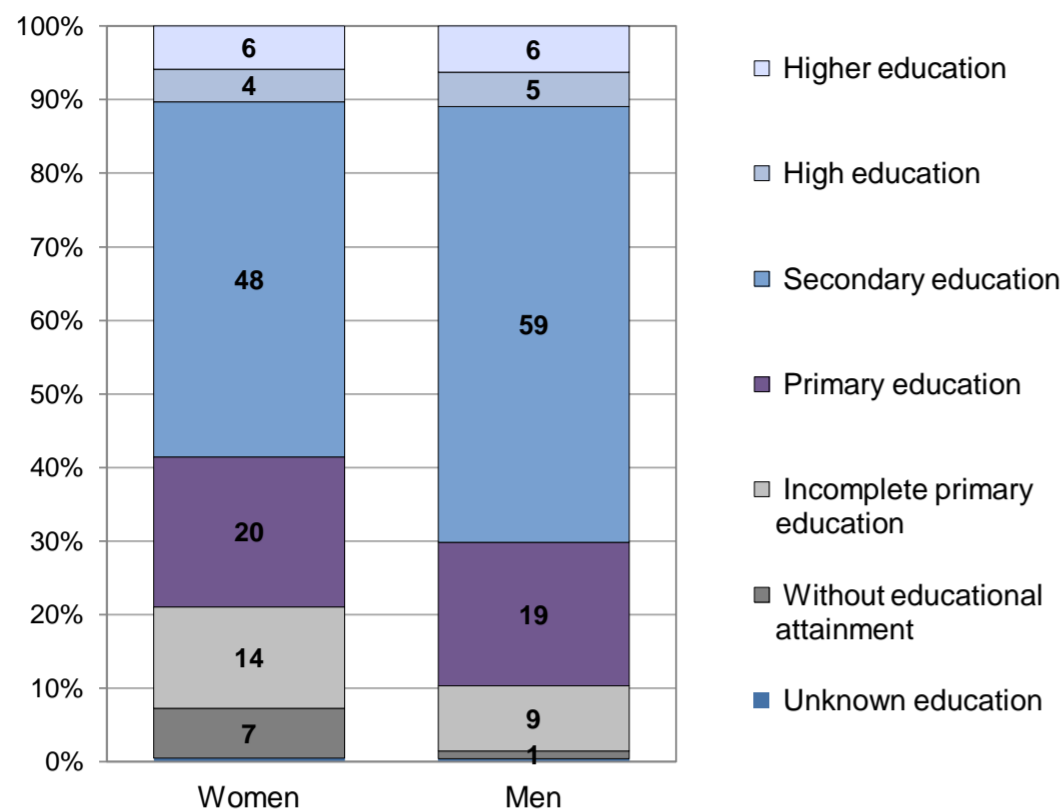

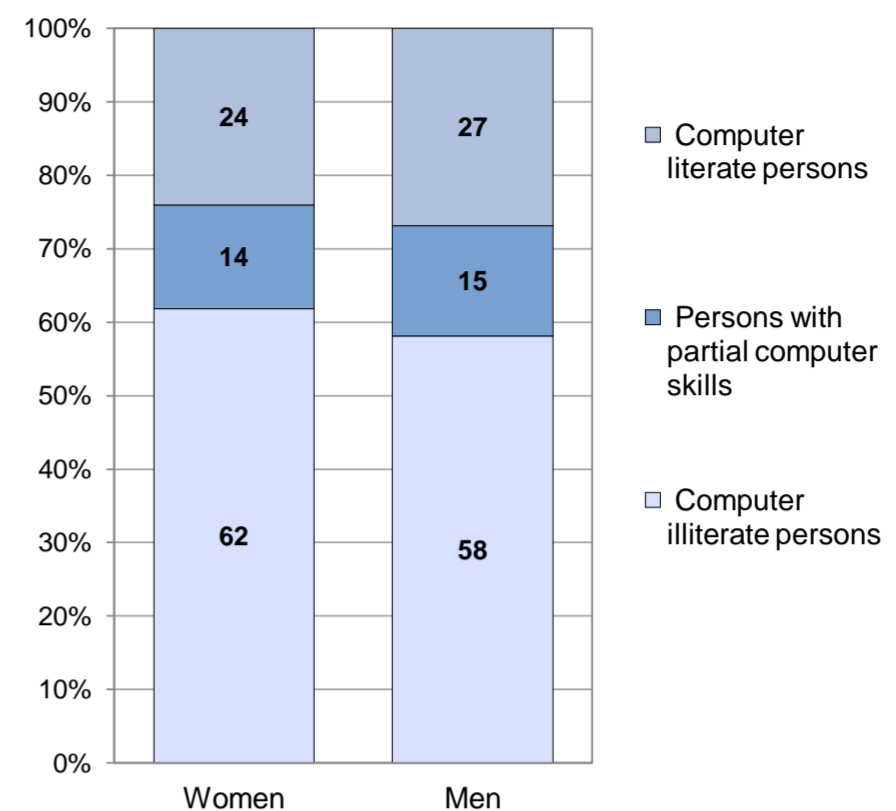

Population aged 15 and over by educational attainment and sex, 2011 (%)



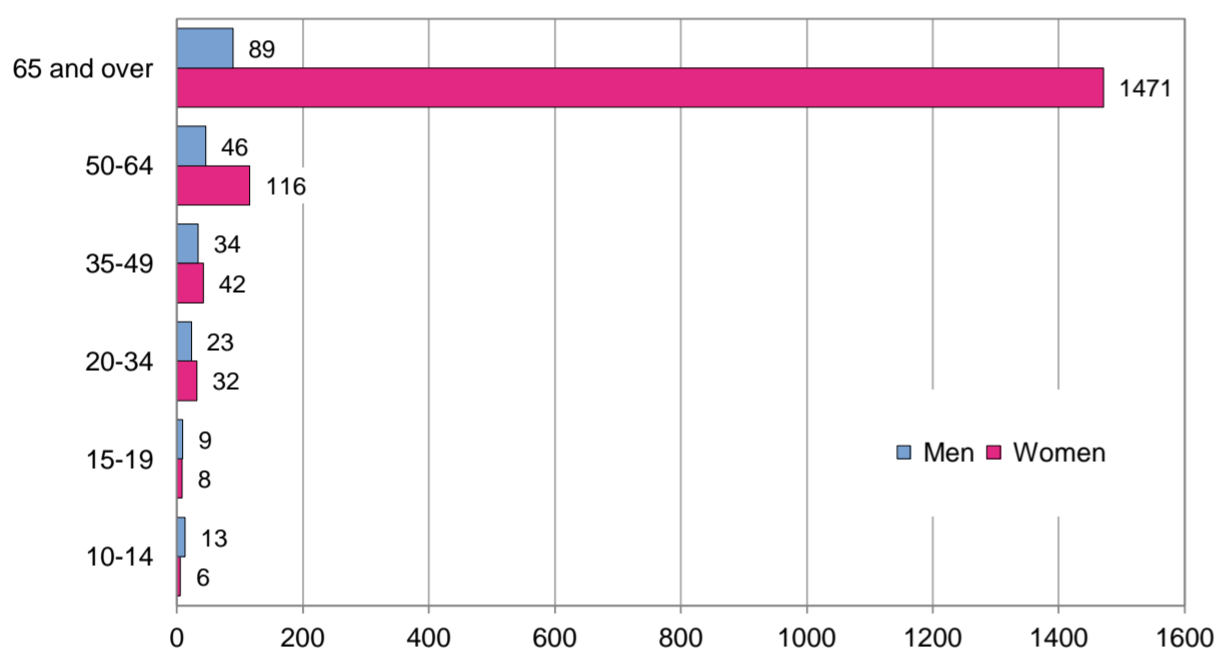

Computer literacy, share by categories, 2011 (%)



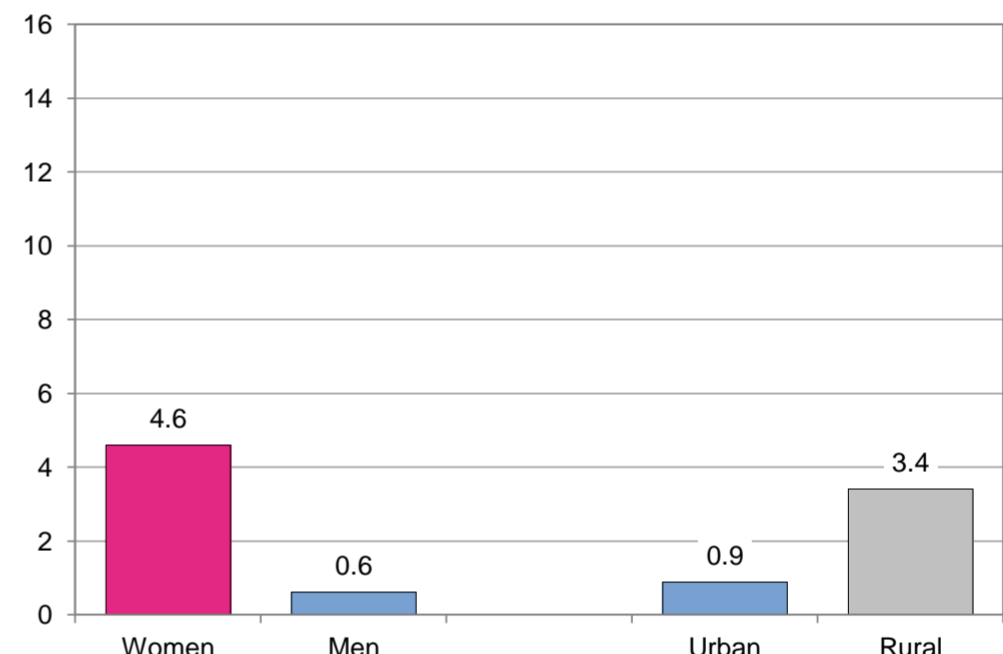

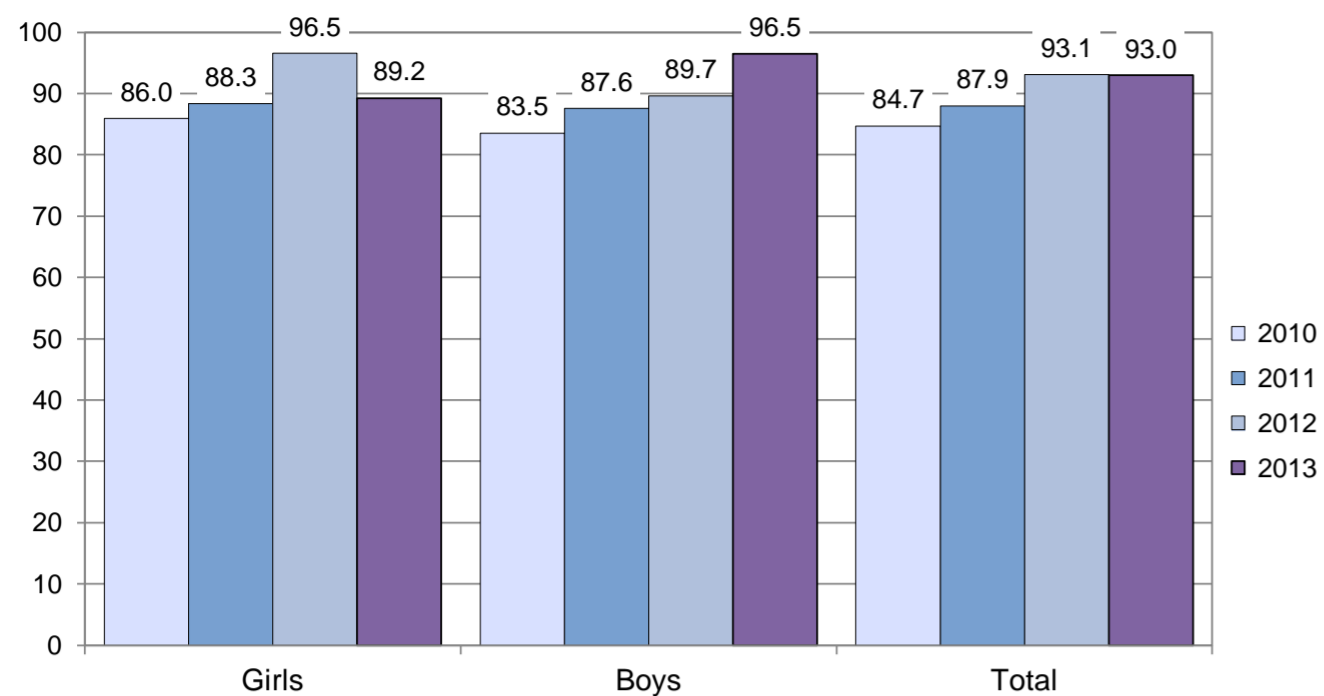

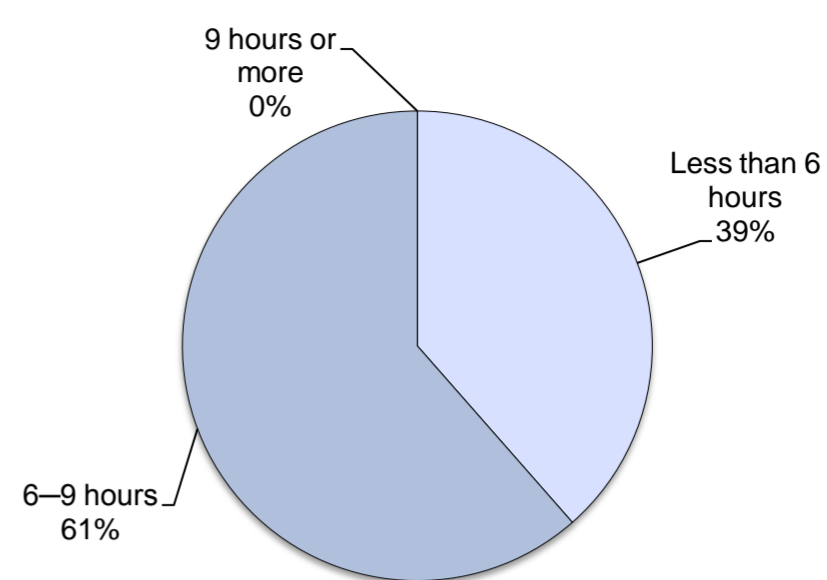

Coverage of children by preparatory preschool programme, 2010–2013 (%)



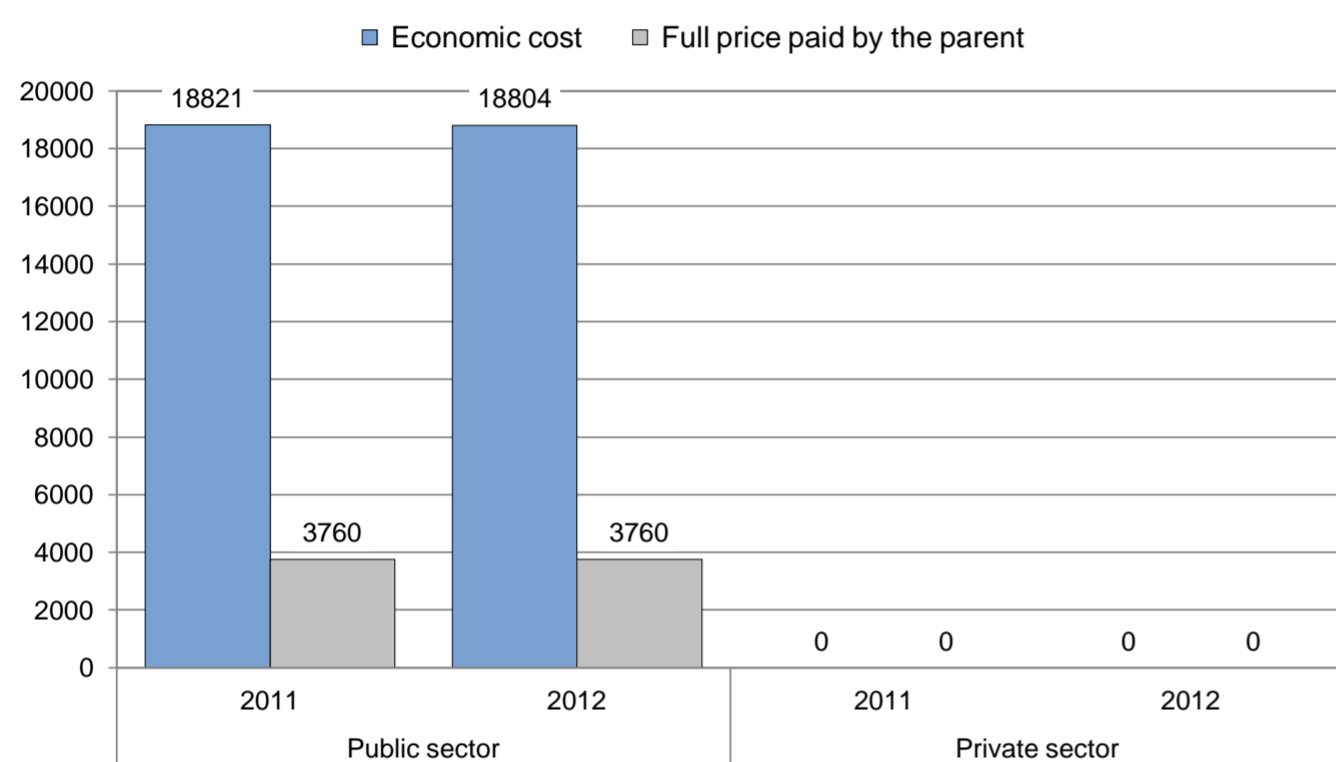

Children attending preschool education, by the duration of stay at day-care centre, 2013 (%)



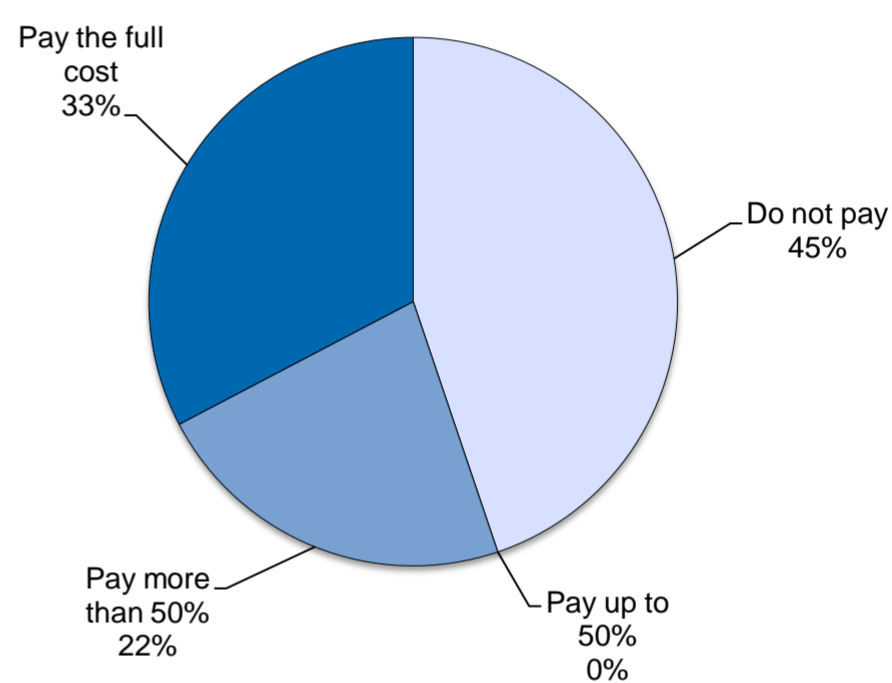

Children attending preschool education, by the share of costs payable by their parents, 2013 (%)



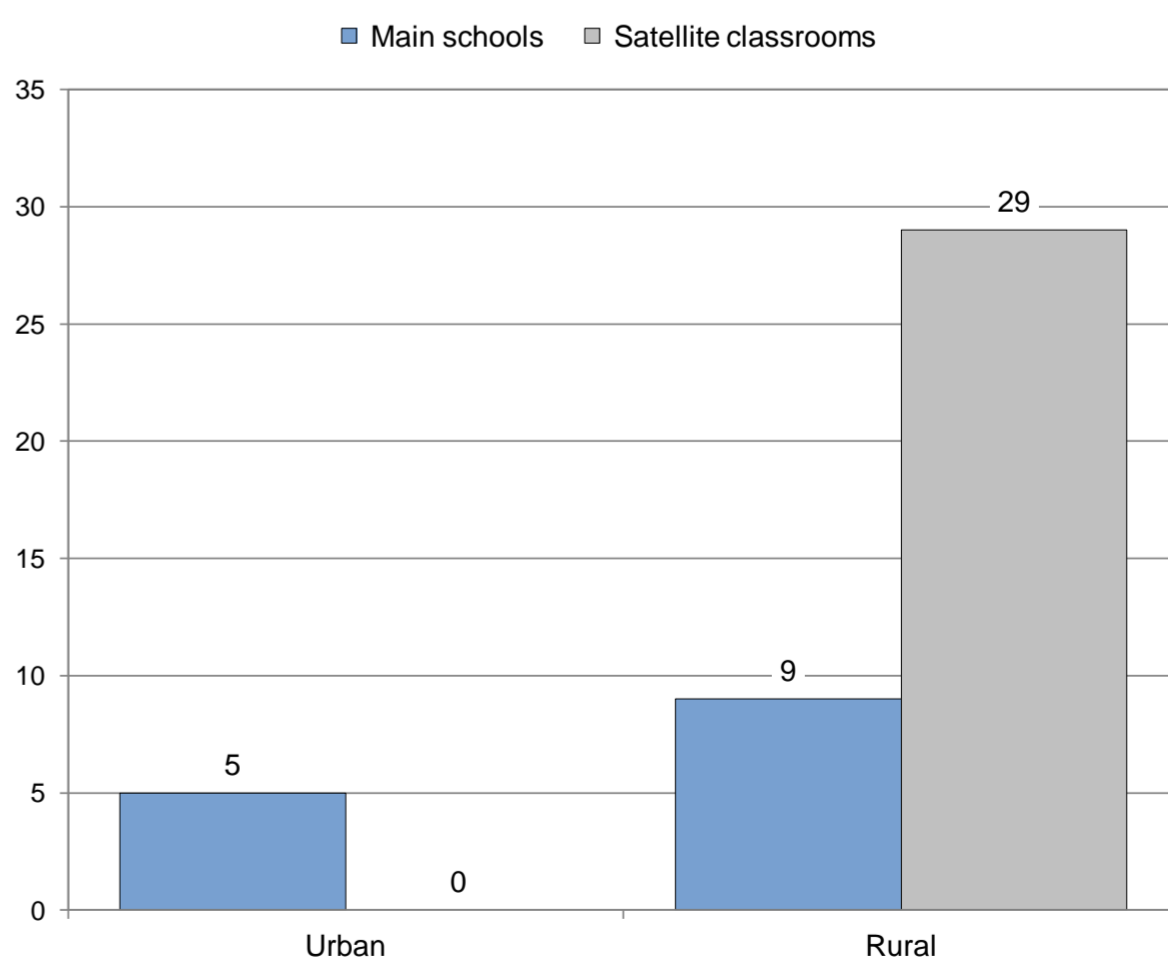

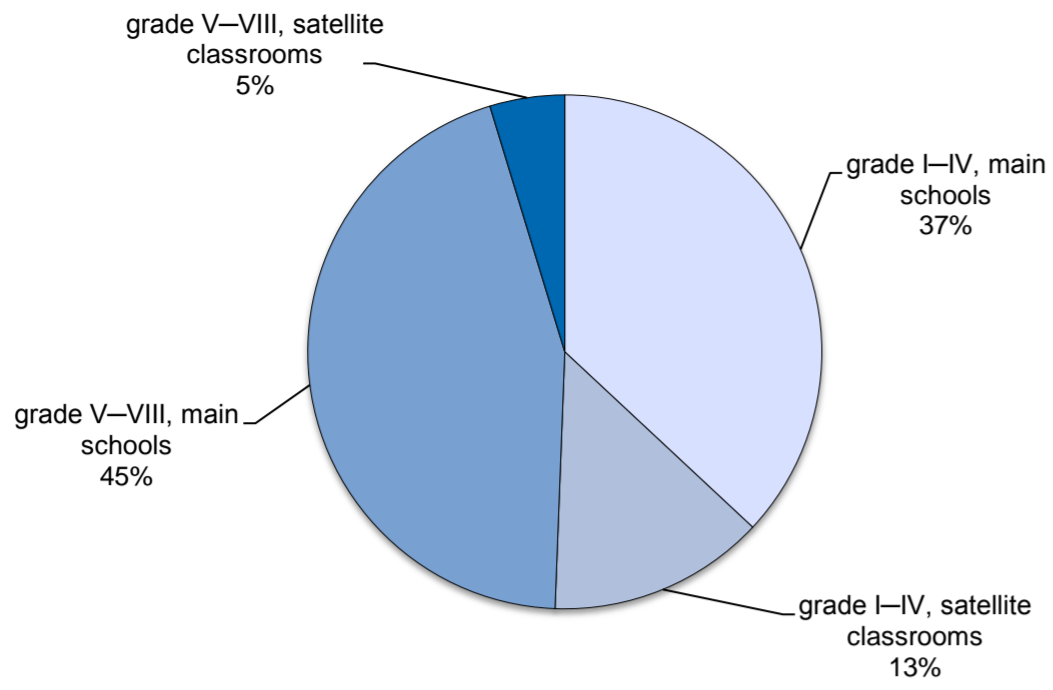

Students enrolled in primary school, 2013 (%)



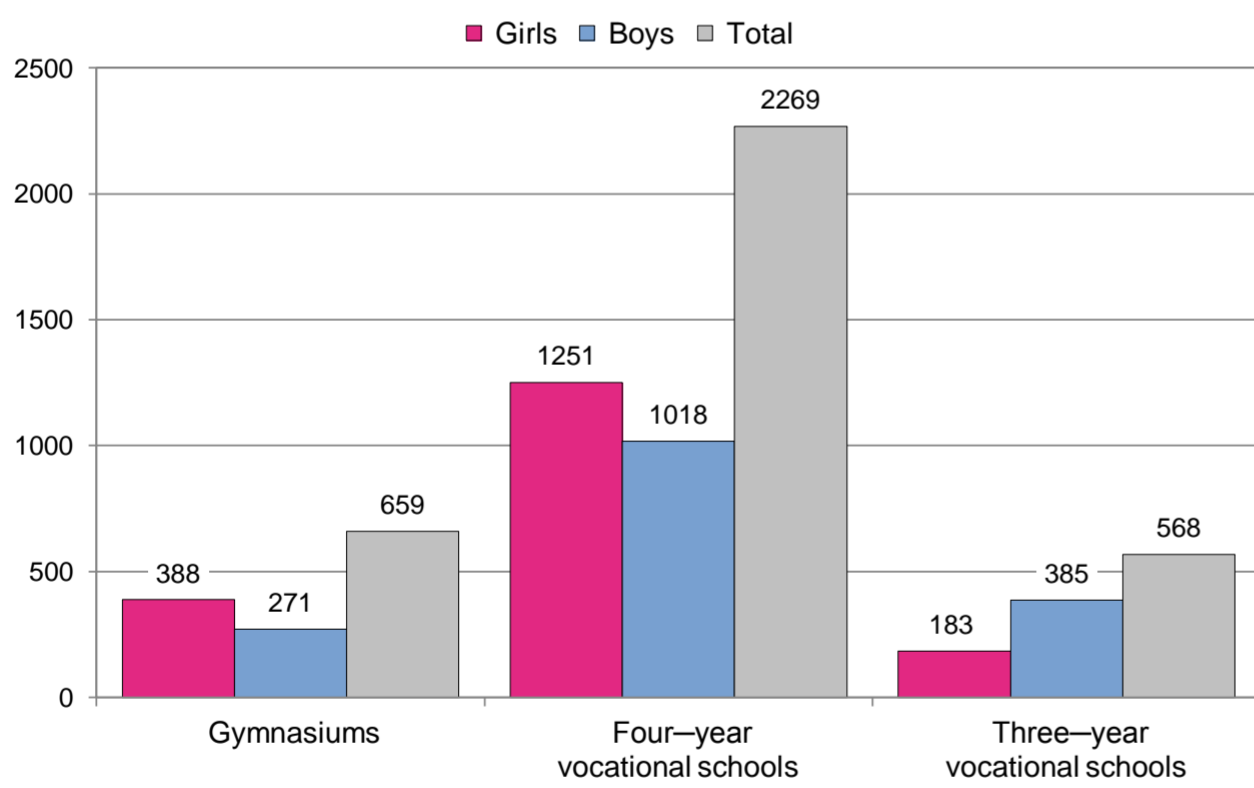

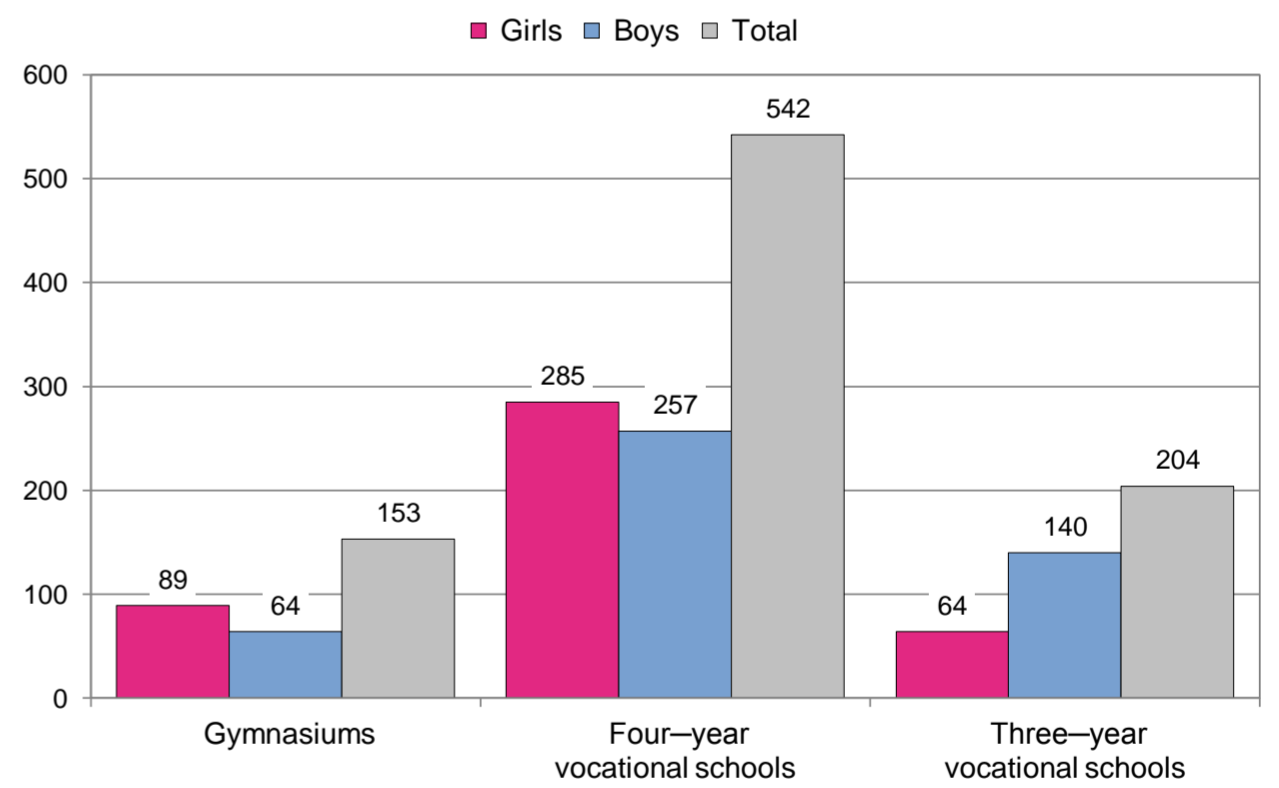

Number of students completing the secondary school, 2012

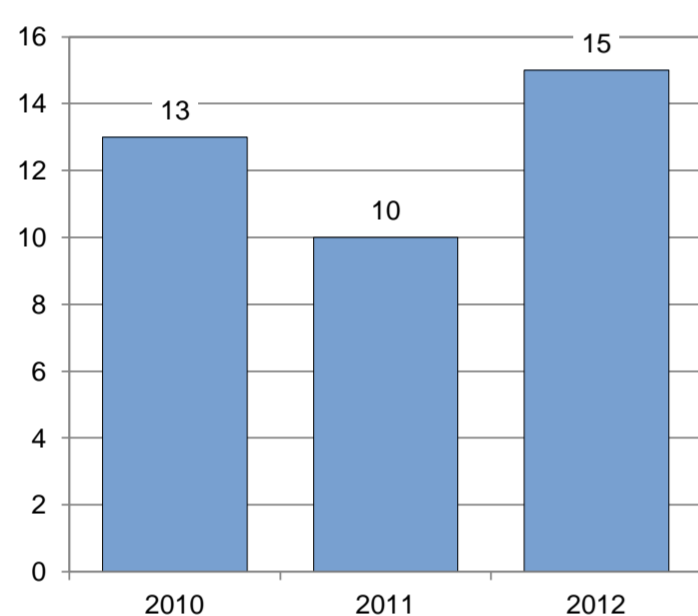

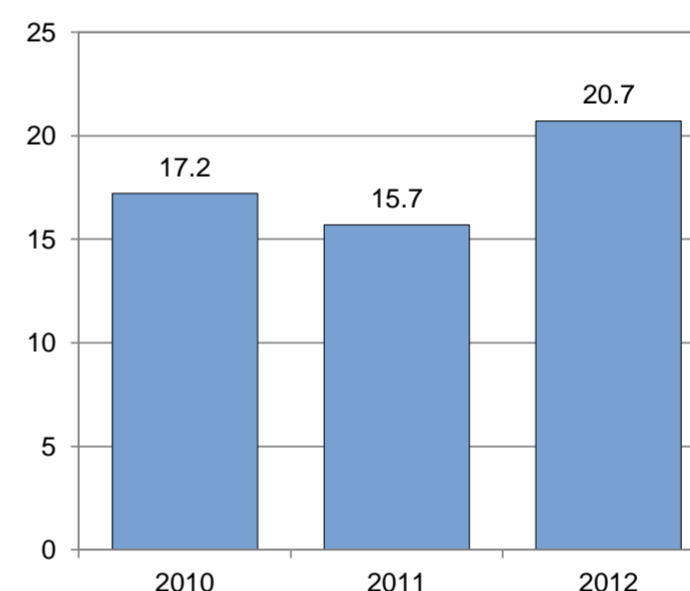

per 1,000 maternals



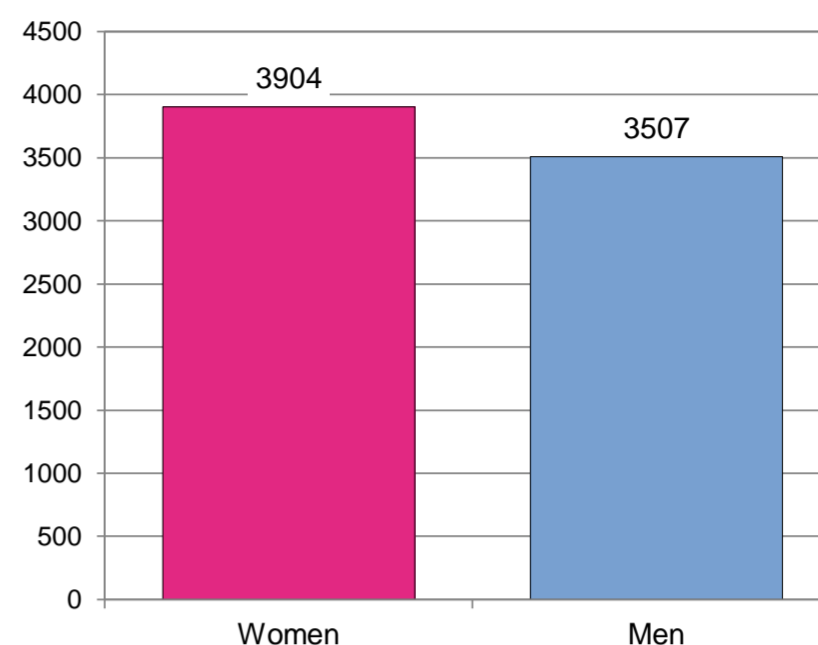

Total number of social welfare beneficiaries recorded by the Centre for Social Work, by sex, 2012



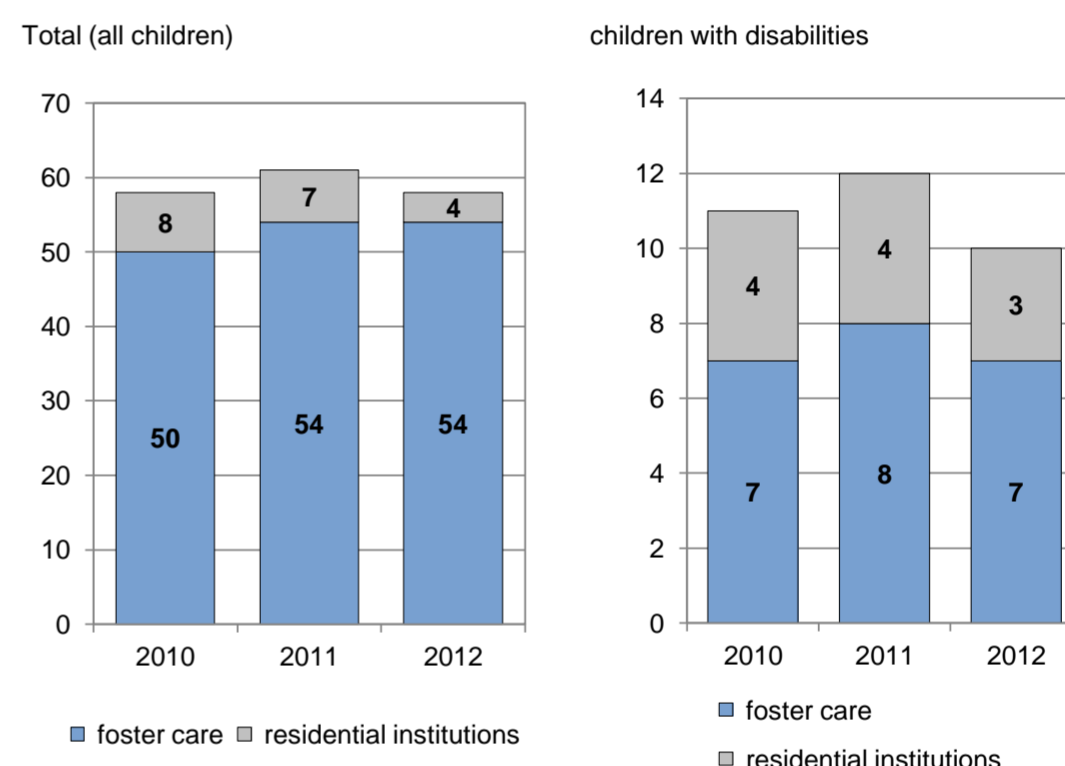

Number of children by type of accommodation, 2010–2012



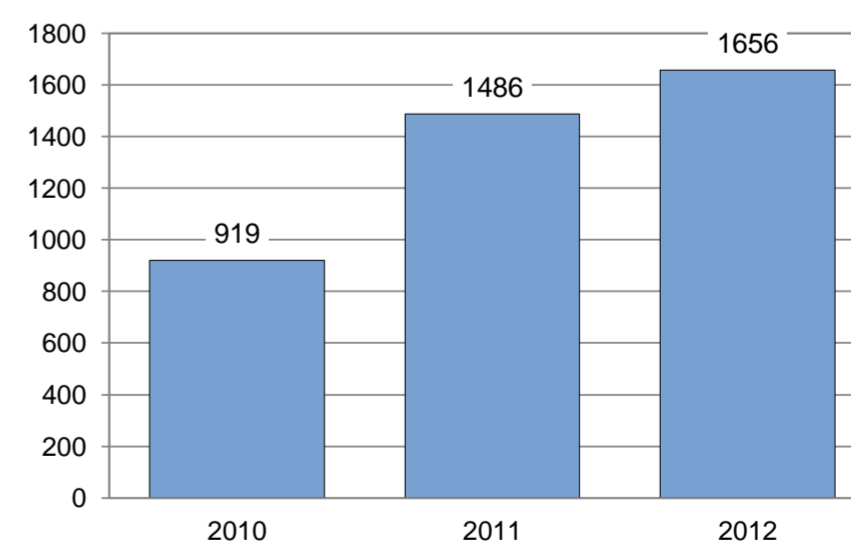

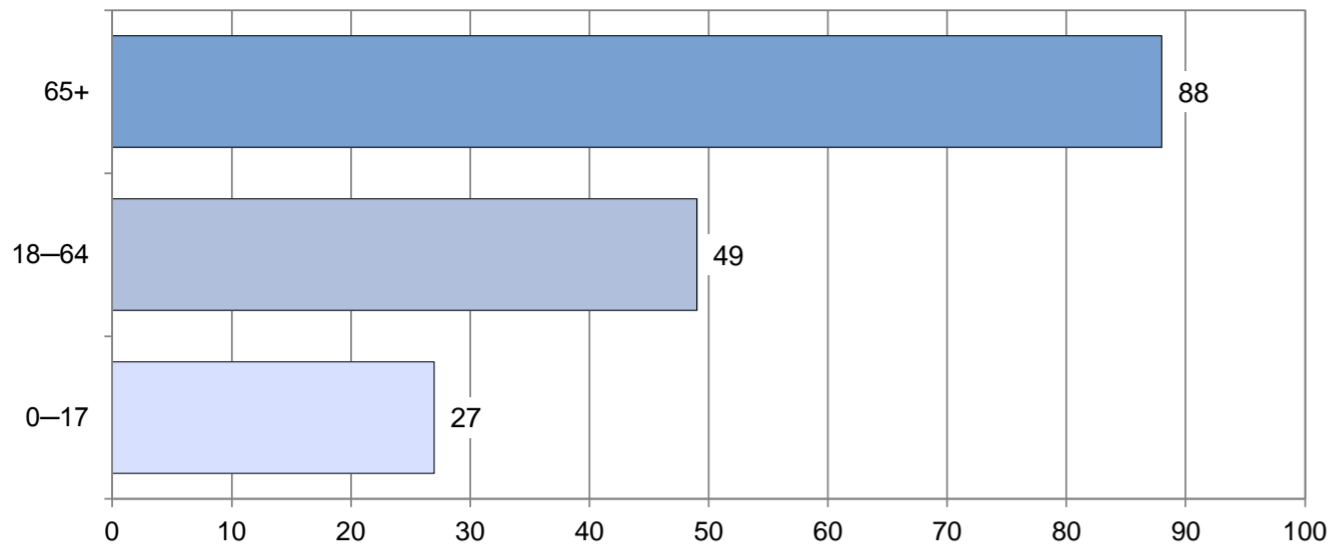

Number of recipients of family cash allowance, 2010–2012



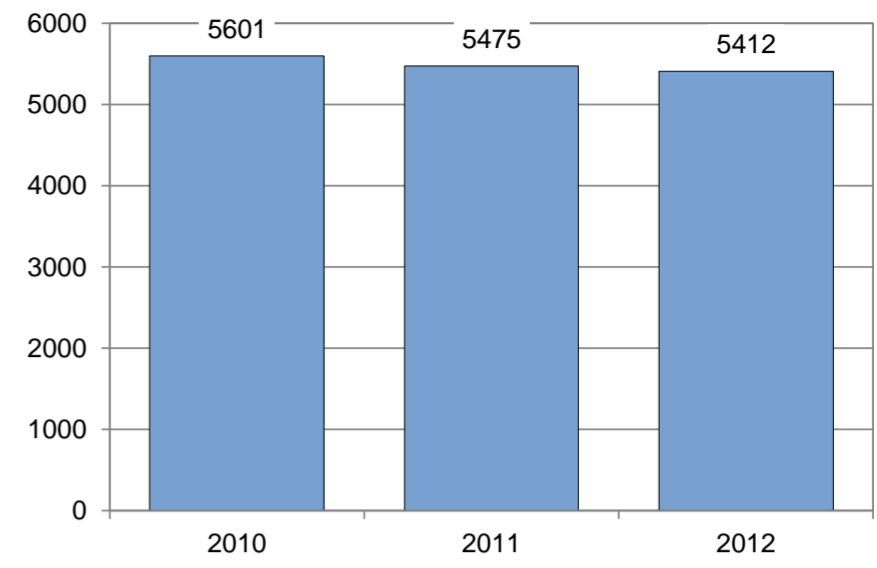

Number of child allowance beneficiaries, 2010-2012



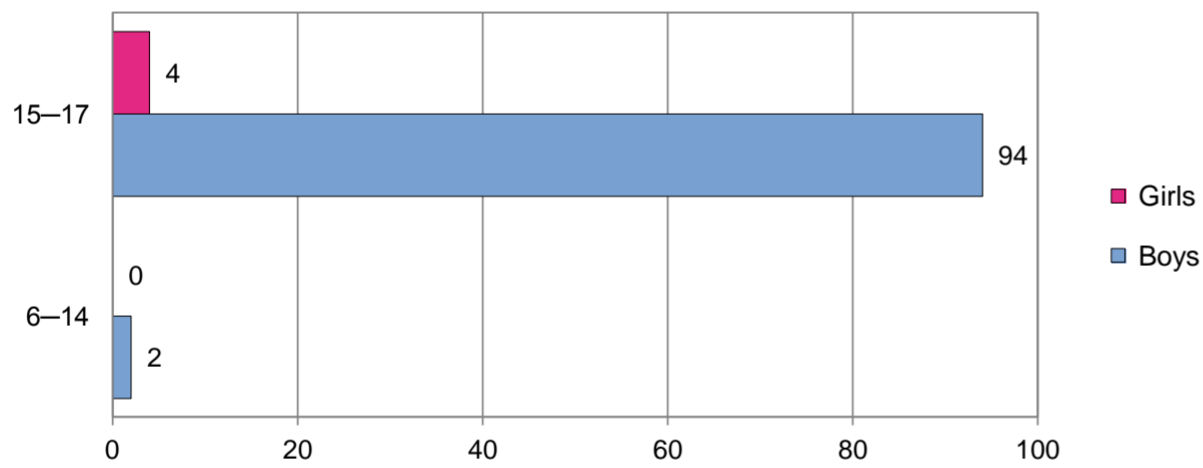

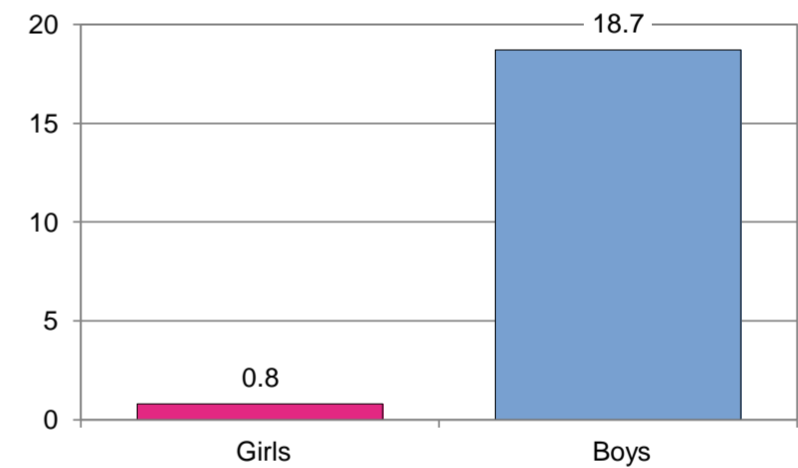

Rate of children aged 6–17 in conflict with the law, by sex, 2012 (per 1,000 children)



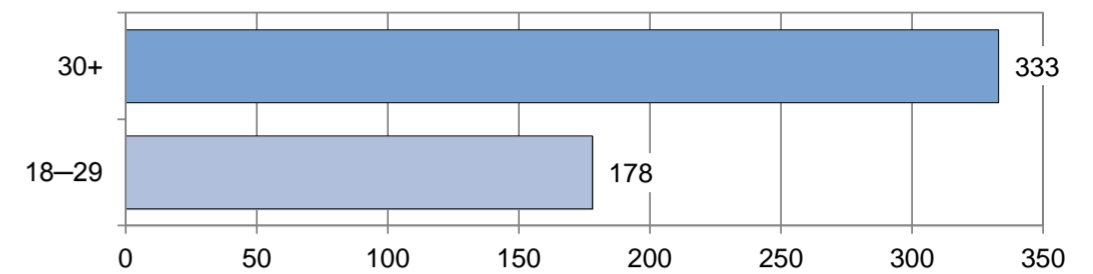

Number of convicted adults, by place of committing criminal offence and age group, 2012



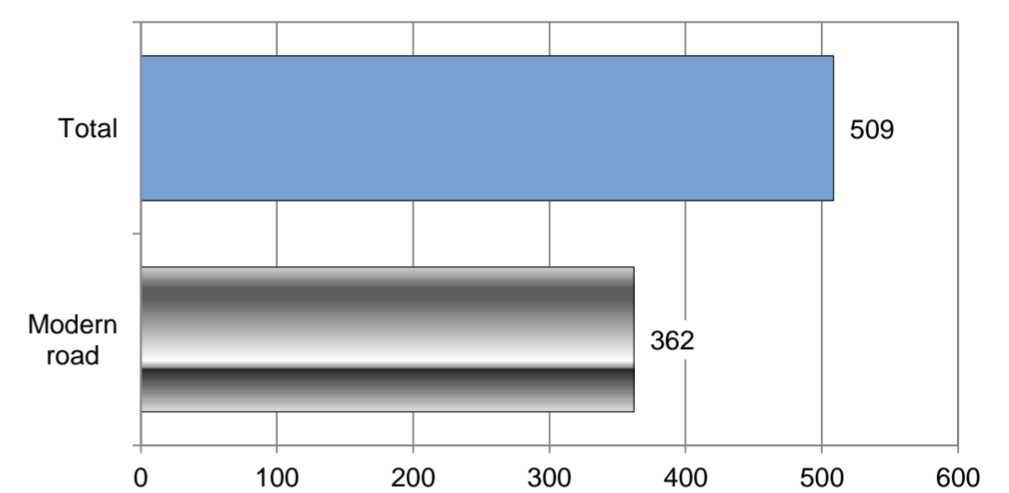

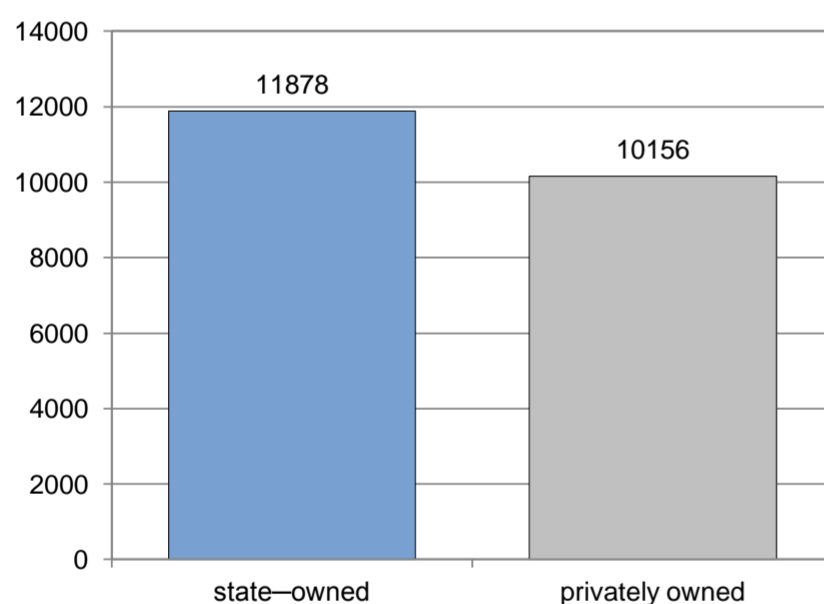

Road length, 2012 (km)



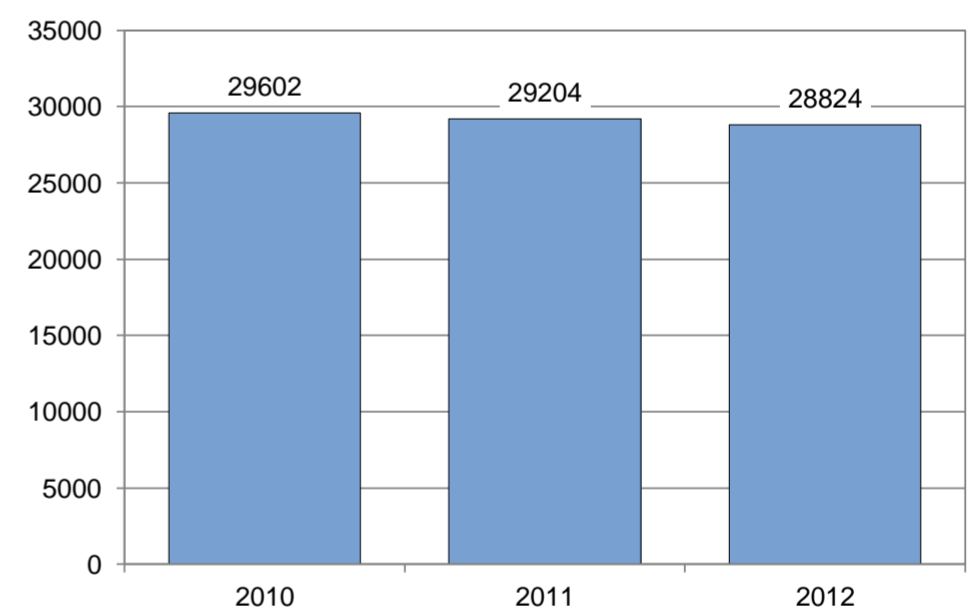
